SUMMER RESEARCH ASSISTANT PROGRAM

The California Rural Indian Health Board, Inc. (CRIHB) California Tribal Epidemiology Center (CTEC), invites college students and recent college graduates to participate in the Summer Research Assistant Program (SRAP) as Summer Research Assistants (SRAs).

An ideal SRAP applicant will be interested in public health research.

ABOUT SRAP

- A paid position 35-hour work week.
- SRAs assist with a short-term, public health research project.
- SRAs are assigned to a host* Indian Health Program (IHP) in either a rural or urban setting. SRAs must either live near the IHP or be willing to relocate for the duration of the program.

*Host sites to be determined

- Scope of the project will be determined by CRIHB CTEC and host IHP.
- SRAs will be assigned a CRIHB CTEC team member as a mentor, who will monitor the progress and completion of research-related projects.
- SRAs will provide regular updates of their progress to their CRIHB CTEC mentor.
- SRAs are required to attend an all-day orientation and introductory training on May 24, 2023.

APPLICATION MATERIALS

Prospective SRAs should submit a resume or curriculum vitae along with a 1-paragraph description of why they are interested in SRAP.
